- ☼ Pictures of all species, and printable copies of the handout and order form, are available on our website at www.itascaswcd.org or in our office at 1889 E. Hwy 2 on the east end of Grand Rapids (actually in La Prairie).

- ☼ **Orders are filled in the order received, so place orders early for best availability.**
- ☼ **Deadline for ordering is Friday April 24th, 2009.**
- ☼ Orders under \$50 must be paid in full, and a minimum deposit of 50% must accompany orders over \$50.
- ☼ Include 6.5% sales tax with your order.
(If you are a tax-exempt organization, a MN tax exempt certificate form ST3 must be included with your order)
- ☼ **Orders will be available for pick-up at the Itasca County Fairgrounds, Thursday and Friday May 14th and 15th 2009 from 11am to 6pm.**

Other General Information

- ☼ **Seed Mixture Planting Instructions:**
For best success rates, seeding areas should receive partial to full sunlight. Remove any pre-existing vegetation, and expose at least partial bare mineral soil. This can be done with hand tools such as rakes, or pull behind drags and discs. Apply the seed evenly on the exposed soil, and then again lightly rake or drag the area to re-incorporate the seed back into the soil. If broadcasting the seed by hand, filler can be incorporated into the seed, to help prevent over-applying and uneven application. Since the seed is light weight, light filler is also best, because the seed and filler stays mixed better. Sand can also be used for filler, but it needs to be remixed often, because the sand and seed separate. Water immediately following seeding.
- ☼ **Plantskydd Deer Repellent:**
Plantskydd is a topical deer repellent. It's a blood derivative and it triggers a predatory reaction in deer. This means that deer don't have to taste it to decide they don't like it; they simply smell it and stay clear. Another benefit of a predatory reaction deer repellent is that you don't need to treat the entire plant; a little bit on the top of the plant is all you need. Fall and spring is when most browsing occurs, when green foliage isn't available, and winter snow isn't protecting dormant ground vegetation. Further, Plantskydd has proven effective for three to six months, so application isn't typically necessary more than twice a year. The quart bottle treats approximately 100 plants 1 foot tall, while the pound of powder needs to be mixed with water and makes four quarts. You can expect the one pound soluble powder concentrate to treat 200 to 400 plants, one foot tall.
