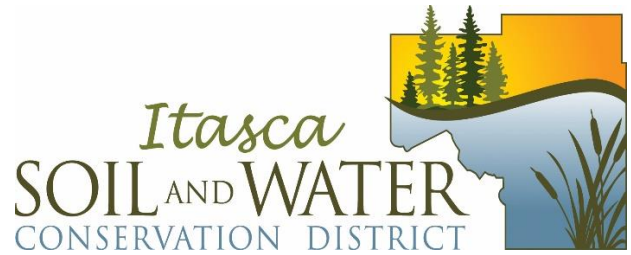

Native Tree Preferences & Facts

<u>Species</u>	<u>Soil/Light Preference</u>	<u>Species Preferences & Growth Rate</u>
Red Pine	Dry/Full	Moderately fast growth, Likes dry/sandy soils. Minnesota state tree
White Pine	Dry or Moist/ Part	Fast grower. Likes moist Loamy soils. Deer candy, be sure to protect young seedings!
White Spruce	Dry/Any	Fast grower. Likes well drained soils. Great wildlife cover.
Black Spruce	Wet/Shade	Typically a slow grower. Likes boggy areas.
Balsam Fir	Well Drained/Part	Fast grower. Likes moist loamy soils. Great Wildlife Cover.
Tamarack	Any/Full	Typically slow grower. Wide soil range. Needles glow vibrant orange/yellow in fall.
White Cedar	Moist/ Any	Slow grower. Prefers lakeshore, or clay loam soils. Recommend protection from deer browsing.
Silver Maple	Wet/Shade	Fast grower. Floodplain species.
Bur Oak	Well Drained/Part	Slow grower. Likes well drained soil, but will grow in a variety of conditions. Acorns!
N. Red Oak	Moist/Part	Fast grower. Prefers dry soils. Acorns for wildlife.
Paper Birch	Well-Drained/Full	Fast grower. Prefers well drained/sandy soils. White paper-like bark.
Red Maple	Well Drained/Part	Moderately fast grower. Grows in an array of soil conditions. Red/yellow in fall.

Native Grasses Preferences & Facts

<u>Species</u>	<u>Soil/Light Preference</u>	<u>Species Traits</u>
Indian Grass	Moist/full	Typically grows 3-5' tall (less frequently to 6') and is noted for its upright form and blue-green foliage.
Big Bluestem	Moist/full	Also known as Turkey Foot. Moderately tolerant of acidity and can withstand periodic flooding and high-water tables
Little Bluestem	Dry/partial	typically matures to 2-4' (less frequently to 5') tall, and features upright clumps of slender, flat, linear green leaves

Seed Mix Information-

Upland/Pollinator-

Designed for full-sun to partial-shade sites with medium soils, this shortgrass mix boasts grasses and most wildflowers at 3', with some flowers reaching 5' at full bloom. Bloom times progress spring through fall.

Shady Woodland-

These species will do well in a medium to medium-dry soil area and currently includes 11 woodland favorites: Columbine, Hairy Wood Mint, Tall Bellflower, Great Waterleaf, Bishop's Cap, Bloodroot, Late Figwort, Zig Zag Goldenrod, Heart-leaved Aster, Drummond's Aster, and Early Meadow Rue. This seed mix will thrive in shaded/semi shaded sites.

Rain Garden/ Wetland Depression-

A selection of species designed to tolerate fluctuating water levels and poor water quality. High diversity allows changes in species composition from the wetter bottom area to the dryer slope. Also, species composition can successfully change with a series of wet or dry years.

Browse Prevention Products-

Tree Shelter- Yellow plastic mesh, 36 inches tall and 4 inches in diameter; each comes with a bamboo stake for securing.

Plantskydd- Plantskydd is a blood derivative which triggers a predatory reaction, and deer are deterred by the smell. It typically needs to be applied spring & fall, & 1 quart treats 100 plants, 1 foot tall. The 1 lb. powder concentrate mixes to make 4 quarts.

Repellex- Repellex is a pill-like tablet added to the soil when planting. Gives plants a hot pepper taste that deters deer and rabbits. One tablet per foot of plant height until out of browse height.
